#### MURRAY STATE UNIVERSITY ENDOWMENT MATCH PROGRAM 2014-2015 Summary Report

This report summarizes the programmatic and financial results of the Endowment Match Program at Murray State University during Fiscal Year 2014-15.

Murray State has received all of its state matching funds. It has also received all its private matching funds as of June 30, 2014. Since the inception of the program in 1998, Murray State has received \$10,070,787 in state matching funds and \$10,070,787 in private matching funds for a total endowment increase of \$20,141,574.

#### **Endowment activity**

With these endowment funds, the University has been able to establish two endowed chairs and five endowed professorships. Both chairs and all five of the professorships were filled during the reporting period. All endowed chairs and professorships reported expenditure activity during the fiscal year.

In addition to the chairs and professorships, the university has been able to create 29 endowed scholarships and 5 mission support endowments. Twenty-eight of the 29 endowed scholarships reported expenditure activity during the year. In addition, one of the five mission support endowments had expenditures in the reporting period. ### **Demographic Information**

All faculty program recipients are males as are the four staff members who participate in the program (Table 2). Both Chairs and four of the occupied professorship occupants are non-Hispanic whites as are all program staff (Table 3). One professorship is occupied by an African American male.
